Choose **ONE** course of Study from each of the lines 1 to 6, by circling or highlighting the course.

It is recommended that students choosing the ATAR pathway select **5 ATAR** subjects.

Students choosing the General pathway are encouraged to select 6 General subjects or 5 General and 1 VET course.

Students have an option to choose **Physical Education or Study** for 2 periods a week. They will make the decision once and are not able to change through the year. Please circle one only.

*Courses combined in some capacity so numbers are limited

** For Outdoor Education, students are required to pass a fitness and swimming test at the commencement of the course and students will need to supply their own 80L hiking rucksack, boots, long sleeved clothes, wide brimmed hat and sleeping bag. Plus a mountain bike, helmet, snorkel, goggles, fins and rain jacket. An optional item would include a wetsuit if students are prone to getting cold.
